

# Risk Assessment

**Before the class the attendees must be briefed on the emergency procedure below:**

In the case of an injury occurring during a FloatFit class the FloatFit instructor will immediately instruct everyone to be seated on their AquaBase. At this point it will then be the responsibility of the lifeguard or staff to enter the water and deal with the injury as required. If the injury is only minor and can be dealt with outside of the pool space, the class may continue upon exit of the injured individual.

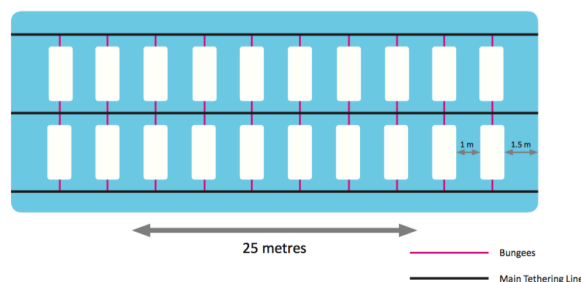
Risk Assessment when using the AquaBase - in addition to existing site and pool risk assessment:

Possible Hazards	Possible Outcome	Control Measures
<u>Set-up</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Falling from the AquaBase</li> <li>The AquaBase floating untethered</li> <li>Equipment damage</li> <li>Misuse of electric pump</li> <li>Insufficient pressure of the AquaBase</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hitting obstruction</li> <li>Risk of injury</li> <li>Equipment unsafe to use</li> <li>Risk of injury or death</li> <li>Risk of injury</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The AquaBase must be tethered 1.5m from the side of the pool and 1m from each other</li> <li>Check that the AquaBase is tethered securely before exercise</li> <li>Regular visual inspections carried out before use to ensure there is no product damage. Carry the AquaBase at all times – dragging will cause damage. Defective items must be deflated and removed from the area</li> <li><b>NEVER</b> use the electric pump around water. Always use the handpump to bring the AquaBase up to the correct pressure</li> <li>Check that the AquaBase pressure is 10PSI before each class (using the handpump gauge)</li> </ul>
<u>Usage</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Competence of instructors</li> <li>Reckless behavior / misuse of equipment</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Unsafe usage</li> <li>Risk of injury</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Adequate supervision by FloatFit trained instructor at all times when the AquaBase is in use</li> <li>All instructors must be a FloatFit certified instructor</li> <li>Never allow any unauthorised persons to use or exercise on the AquaBase</li> </ul>
<u>Storage</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AquaBase storage area</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Danger to equipment and personnel</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make sure that the AquaBase are safely stacked with regular inspection of the area. The area must be kept clean and tidy</li> </ul>
